

The stunning Bull Mountain Ranch consists of 12,467.529 +/- total deeded acres, with an additional 640 adjacent acres of state land with no ground public access. With an abundancy of water and diversity of habitat, this ranch is home to a variety of wildlife, including a large number of trophy elk. From big game to birds, the hunting on Bull Mountain Ranch is second to none.




With numerous water lines, 3 lined ponds, and 25 tanks— concrete and fiberglass— having two or three per pasture, water is always less than a mile from anywhere on the property. The land is very well-watered with excellently developed springs, many of which flow year round.



## LAND

The Bull Mountain Ranch has approximately 500 acres of alfalfa strategically placed in the mountains, with 300 acres (two fields) of that historically watered with a wheel line. The watering system is winterized, so the water does not have to be turned off, which also provides the elk with a perfect habitat and refuge to go to, without public pressure.


